

## **Anne-Marie Rindom**

### **Laser Radial**

Anne-Marie Rindom is hands-down one of the best Laser Radial sailors in the world. Again and again, the 30-year-old from Horsens, Denmark has distinguished herself as a top sailor in the biggest international events. Deeply focused and competitive, Rindom is a fighter who gives it her all. She does not give up if she encounters adversity. Instead, she goes home and analyses what she can do better. She is tough as nails mentally and often achieves peak performance when the pressure is at its highest.

Rindom's Olympic debut was at the age of 20 in 2012 when she won 13th place in London. In 2014 she began to seriously move up the ranks to be among the best in the class. In 2015 alone, she was on the podium six times at top events, winning gold at the World Championship in Oman as her crowning achievement.

At the 2016 Rio Olympics, Rindom was up against high expectations, which she met by winning bronze, Denmark's first-ever Olympic medal in a Laser class. Since then she won gold in 2019 at both the World and European Championships and was among the top three at virtually every event she participated in. In 2019, she won five out of six events, and World Sailing named her Women's World Sailor of the Year.

After the Corona pandemic hit, almost all competitions were cancelled. The 2020 European Champion was nonetheless held and Rindom came home with a silver medal.

In recent years she has trained tirelessly for the Tokyo Olympics. If everything goes according to plan, she can look forward to being among those at the pinnacle of the field.
