

Jonas Warrer and Jakob Precht

49er

Jonas Warrer (42), together with Martin Kirketerp, won Olympic gold in the 49er class in Beijing/Qingdao 13 years ago in 2008. The broken mast, the borrowed Croatian boat and the protracted administrative commotion that took place – before the Olympic gold was definitively awarded – is one of the most dramatic chapters of Danish sport history.

Since triumphing at the Olympics Warrer has sailed with several different deckhands, including Anders Thomsen, with whom he won silver at the 2014 World Championship. During his second Olympics in 2016 he won fourth place with Christian Peter Lübeck. At 42, Warrer remains passionate about and happy with 49er sailing, which is why his attention is now focused on his third Olympic Games – Tokyo 2020.

He will participate with the just 22-year-old Jakob Precht Jensen, an extremely talented young deckhand who has found a promising collaboration with the experienced Olympic legend in an impressively short amount of time. Warrer and Precht have achieved a high level of excellence, with two victories at Kieler Woche in 2018 and 2020 and their selection for the Tokyo Olympics, where their goal is to win a medal.
