Lærke Buhl-Hansen (29) is one of the most talented Danish windsurfers around and among the world's top ten. Born and raised in Malling, a small village outside Aarhus, Denmark, she started with the optimist dinghy before switching to the Olympic windsurfing class RS:X at the age of 17. Since then she has participated in countless events at home and abroad.

In 2016 she was selected for the Rio Olympics, where she won fifteenth place overall. Since then her career has done nothing but advance. Today she is among the best in the windsurfing class, which is a big one internationally.

This year she sailed in both the European and World Championships, where she achieved the best results of her career. In the European Championship she qualified for the Medal Race and landed an overall eighth place before subsequently finishing in ninth place in the World Championship.

Buhl-Hansen's strategy is to focus on what she is exceptionally good at and to refuse to overcomplicate large events. This approach has led her all the way to the top of world's elite.
